

Pre-College Piano Jury Requirements

- Students are required to provide a repertoire list citing all works learned during the year, including an (*) to designate works prepared for the jury.
- Students will be expected to play a minimum of 3 different styles for all juries and all age groups.
- The duration of the jury, as well as the minimum length of the repertoire presented are listed below:

Age 10 and under:

Jury length: 10 minutes

Minimum amount of repertoire prepared: 20 minutes

Age 11 to 14:

Jury length: 15 minutes

Minimum amount of repertoire prepared: 30 minutes

Age 15 and above:

Jury length: 15 minutes

Minimum amount of repertoire prepared: 40 minutes

Minimum Repertoire Requirements:

Ages 10 and under:

- One work by J. S. Bach
- One Etude or work representing similar technical demands
- At least two additional works of different styles

Ages 11 to 14:

- One work by J. S. Bach
- Two Etudes
- At least three complete works of different styles

Age 15 and above:

- One complete work by J. S. Bach, excluding Inventions
- Two Etudes
- One complete classical sonata
- One romantic work
- One 20th/21st Century work
