

Permission to record does not grant the right to post the recordings on YouTube, social media or other publicly viewed websites.

SOLO RECITALS

Parents of the performer may use their own video and audio recording equipment, as per the guidelines below:

Designated recording areas:

IN PAUL HALL - The two designated areas are located in the wheelchair accessible locations in the back of Paul Hall on the far left and far right sections of the audience. All recording equipment must be battery operated. Tripods and microphone stands are permitted. **IN MORSE HALL** – The one designated area is located in the center aisle in the rear of the hall. All recording equipment must be battery operated. Tripods and microphone stands are permitted.

- The use of extension cords and cables are strictly prohibited in all Juilliard performance spaces.
- Parents are prohibited from recording their child's performance while sitting in the audience.
- Flash photography during the performance is prohibited.

The Juilliard Recording Department offers services for professional audio (CD) and video (DVD) recording.

To arrange for a recording through Juilliard, you must contact the Recording Department <u>AT LEAST TWO WEEKS BEFORE</u> your recital.

Requests made after the two week deadline will not be accommodated.

CHAMBER MUSIC in Paul Hall. Morse Hall and Willson Theater

Parents of the performer may use their own video and audio recording equipment, as per the guidelines below:

- Parents of the performers may record only their own child's chamber group performance.
- Designated recording areas:

IN PAUL HALL – The two designated areas are located in the wheelchair accessible locations in the back of Paul Hall on the far left and far right sections of the audience. All recording equipment must be battery operated. Tripods and microphone stands are permitted. **IN MORSE HALL** – The one designated area is located in the center aisle in the rear of the hall. All recording equipment must be battery operated. Tripods and microphone stands are permitted.

IN WILLSON THEATER – Parents may use handheld, battery-operated video-recording equipment from the last (back) row in the audience. Tripods and microphone stands are <u>not</u> allowed in Willson Theater.

- The use of extension cords and cables are strictly prohibited in all Juilliard performance spaces.
- Parents are prohibited from recording their child's performance while sitting in the audience.
- Flash photography during the performance is prohibited

The **Juilliard Recording Department** automatically audio records all chamber music recitals in Paul Hall and Morse Hall (inquire about Willson). Recordings can be purchased by contacting the Recording Department directly.

PIANO PERFORMANCE FORUM (pianists only)

Parents of the performer may use their own video and audio recording equipment, as per the guidelines below:

- Parents of the performers may only record their child's performance.
- Designated recording areas:

IN PAUL HALL – The two designated areas are located in the wheelchair accessible locations in the back of Paul Hall on the far left and far right sections of the audience. All recording equipment must be battery operated. Tripods and microphone stands are permitted. **IN MORSE HALL** – The one designated area is located in the center aisle in the rear of the hall. All recording equipment must be battery operated. Tripods and microphone stands are permitted.

- The use of **extension cords and cables** are strictly prohibited in all Juilliard performance spaces.
- Parents are prohibited from recording their child's performance while sitting in the audience.
- Flash photography during the performance is prohibited.

The Juilliard Recording Department offers services for professional audio (CD) and video (DVD) recording. To arrange for a recording, you must contact the Recording Department AT LEAST TWO WEEKS BEFORE your performance. Requests made after the two week deadline will not be accommodated.

ORCHESTRA CONCERTS

Individual recording of any kind at any orchestra concert is strictly prohibited. This includes concerts in Peter Jay Sharp Theater and Alice Tully Hall.

The Juilliard Recording Department automatically audio records all orchestra concerts. Recordings can be purchased by contacting the Recording Department directly.
